Minutes

1. Shared the children were to welcome guests to their classrooms with a handshake. We all practised with each other.
2. All classes could describe their individual class reward system. Some commented that they liked Y4 system that you got the reward eg 5 min extra play at a certain number of dojo points and not just the first to get there. They felt this was fairer.
3. Positive response to the class names. Eva shared it was really interesting finding out facts about new people. Martha asked Y2 who Brunel was and the children could talk about him confidently. Mrs Darlison asked if they could start to think of a name for her office.
4. Eva and Dexter brought their books to share and talked confidently



about the book that had been chosen and how it had inspired them to buy a book by the same author at the Book Fair. All classes could name and talk about the book they had used during the week. Runya shared that she thought it was a great idea for the first week back as you could get to know your teachers without having to worry about understanding the new Year 4 maths. Year 6 shared that in their classes the girls had really enjoyed their book but the boys hadn't enjoyed it as much. All agreed it was a great way to start the year and would like to do more weeks like this.

5. All counsellors had the opportunity to share the clubs they had attended this half term. Many expressed their disappointment that they hadn't been able to get a space in the Vision after school clubs, but were hoping to next time. Most had been to at least one club and had been enjoying them. They shared suggestions for other clubs they would like to see in future which included gymnastics, knitting, sewing and dance.
6. CD briefly shared the plans to start the discussion again this year around our school logo and the plan to ask children to design it, and getting their classes excited about it would be important. Some were very excited about this. Jacob-Lee asked if it would also include changing the colours of the school because that would be expensive for people. CD explained it would be just the badge and we were looking at getting badges that could be sewn on, and that they wouldn't be expected to have brand new uniform straight away.
