Match 2 - Weddington 4 - all saints 4

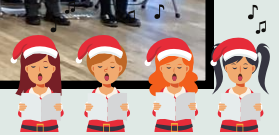
Match 3 - Weddington 1 - Michael Drayton 4

A lovely afternoon albeit a bit cold and muddy

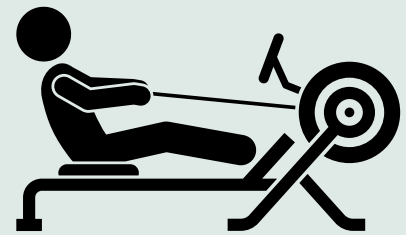


Carols Around the Tree - Y5 & 6
