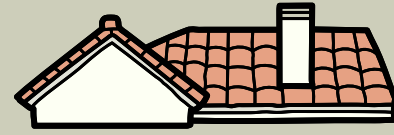

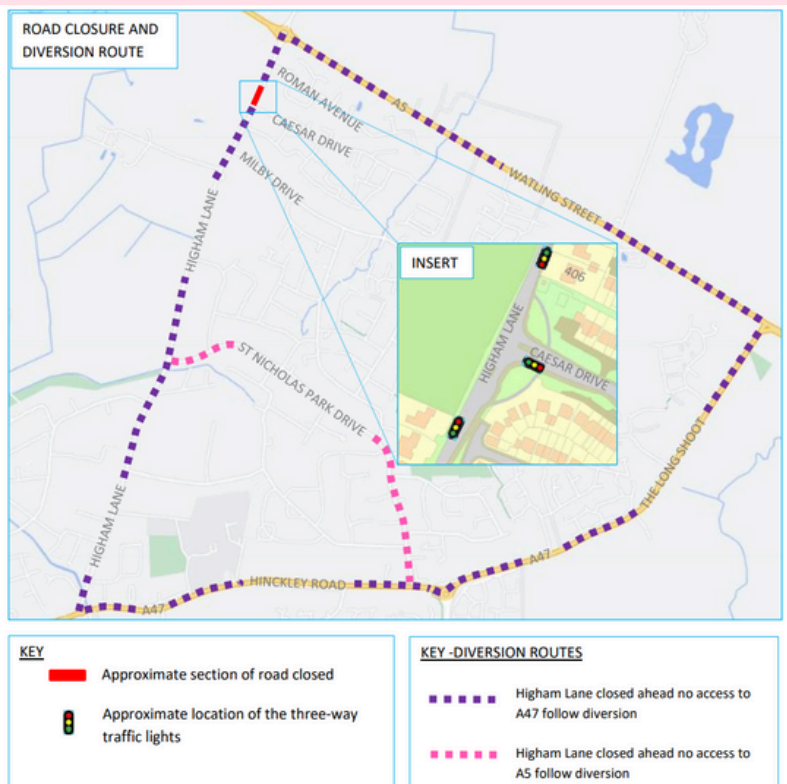

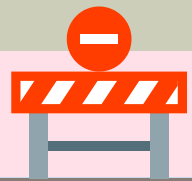
Travelling Book Fair
