Applications open for 2025 Secondary School Places

The deadline for applying for a Year 7 secondary school place is:

OCTOBER
31



All applications received by the deadline of 31 October will receive a school offer on 3 March next year, which is National Offer Day.

Any applications submitted after the deadline will only be considered after this, meaning the child is much less likely to be offered a place at a preferred school.
