## Exciting news!

After reviewing our after school club provision and listening to our families and staff, we have designed a new after school club provision for all of our children at Weddington.

We looked at different options and I can now announce that from September 2024, we have partnered with Vision Football Academy.

Along with the other after school clubs that will be run by Weddington Staff, Vision will be running **4 after school clubs every week for the whole year**. This will mean an extra **24** sports related clubs throughout the school year run by professional coaches. In total, this would be approximately **42** clubs being offered to our children through the school year.

One of the clubs that will be run by Vision will be a Girls Football club that will be offered to girls for the **WHOLE YEAR**.

In addition to this, there will also be the *Weddington Aspire Club*. This again will be run **ALL YEAR** and will be aimed for our children who have particular learning needs - this will include children with SEN or other developmental, social needs etc. This club will be by invitation only. If you feel your child may benefit from this club, please get in touch with the school.
