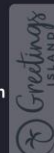

## Parent Survey Update:

Thank you again for your responses for the survey.

We are always looking for your opinion about our school and will act on areas that need to be further developed. The three areas that families want to develop are: behaviour, car parking and the sharing of their child's curriculum.

Behaviour was a common theme in the survey and because of this, we have created a new Relationship and Behaviour Policy.

### The purpose of this policy is to ensure the following:

- Creating a culture that promotes excellent behaviour
- Weddington has high expectations of children's conduct and behavior which is commonly understood by all staff, parents, children and Governors
- Behaviour does not disrupt teaching, learning, school routines or has a negative impact on wellbeing
- Prevent all forms of bullying (including cyberbullying, prejudice-based and discriminatory bullying)
- Ensure that pupils complete any tasks reasonably assigned to them in connection with their education
- Encourage students to take responsibility for their actions
- Address social and emotional needs of students
- Establish consistent guidelines for behavior management
- Parents understand how they can support the school's behaviour policy

**As this was a priority for many parents, we are inviting parents to show and discuss this new Relationship and Behaviour Policy on Wednesday 11<sup>th</sup> October at 4pm and Monday 16<sup>th</sup> October at 4pm.**
