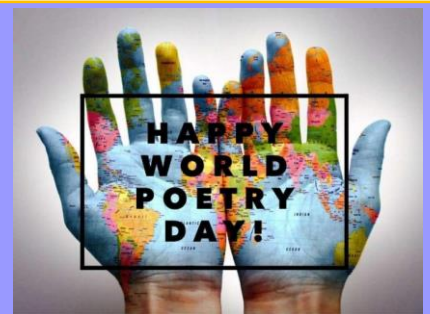
### Macmillan Day
