# SPRING DISCO



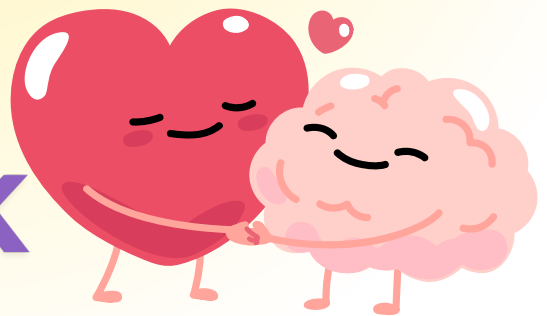
Thank you all for supporting the discos this week.

The previous signs were loaned to us by the Local Community Watch. We want to thank them for this loan and support these past few months.

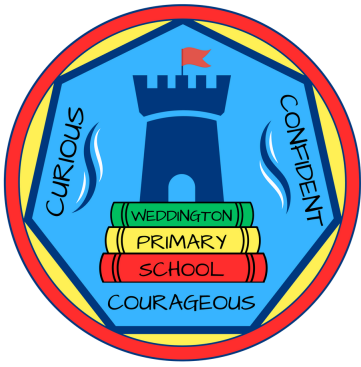


## Children's MENTAL HEALTH WEEK

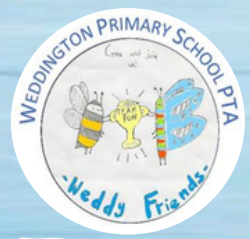

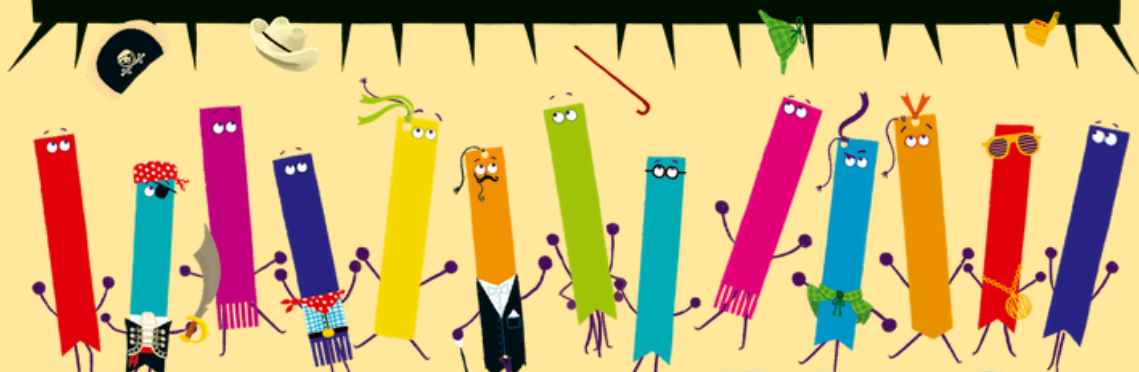

ALL AFTER SCHOOL CLUBS will begin the week beginning 03.03.25 for 5 weeks.

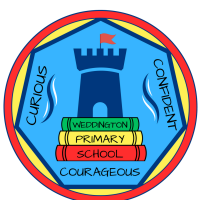

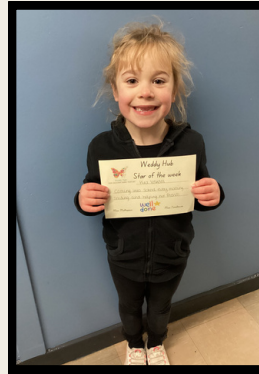
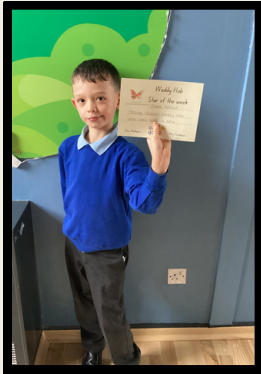
