Celebrating Our Amazing KS1 Achievers! 🎉

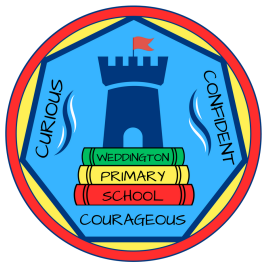

Once again, thank you to everyone for your support and for completing the survey. Another big thank you and well done to all of the staff that did an amazing job this week.

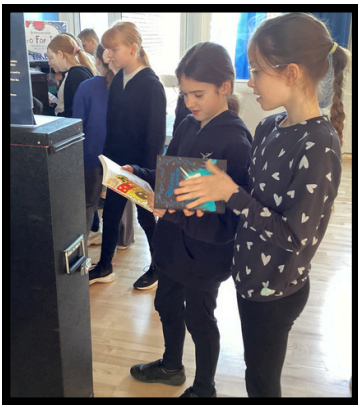


Parent WhatsApp Groups

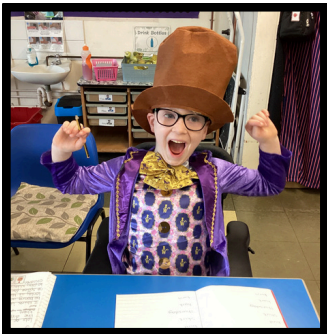
We appreciate that there are parent WhatsApp groups across school. This of course is a good way for families to share key messages and build relationships with each other.

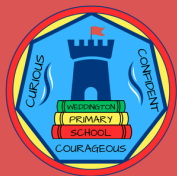
