Parent evenings

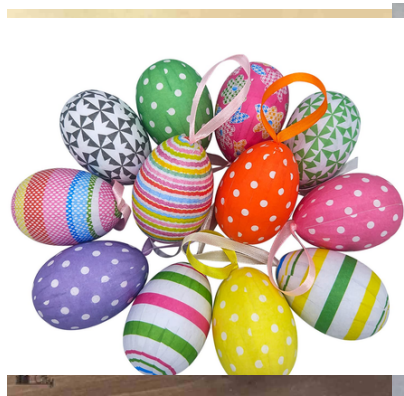
