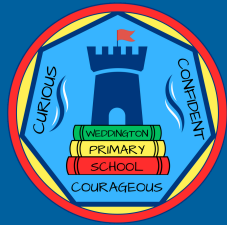

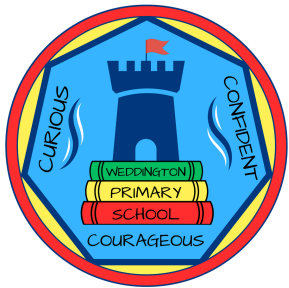
Each certificate awarded tells a story of kindness, hard work, honesty or courage—and we couldn't be prouder!

A big thank you to our fantastic families for your support in helping our children shine so brightly. Together, we build something special. 🌟



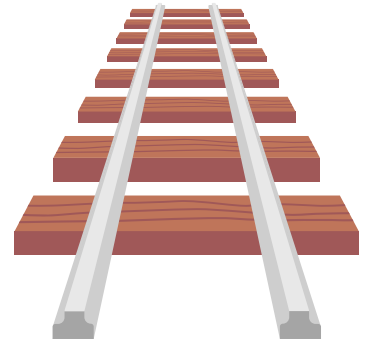
KS1 Football Competition

Stay Safe Around Railways and Train Stations 🚂⚠️



Here are some important tips to help keep you safe:

🚫 Never go near train tracks – they are dangerous, even if no train is coming.

🚶 Only cross at **proper crossings** – never climb over barriers or fences.

🎧 Take out headphones and stop using phones near tracks so you can hear trains.

🛑 Always stop, look and listen before using a proper crossing.

👁️ Trains move fast and are very quiet – they can come when you least expect it.

👨👩 Stay close to your adult when at a train station.

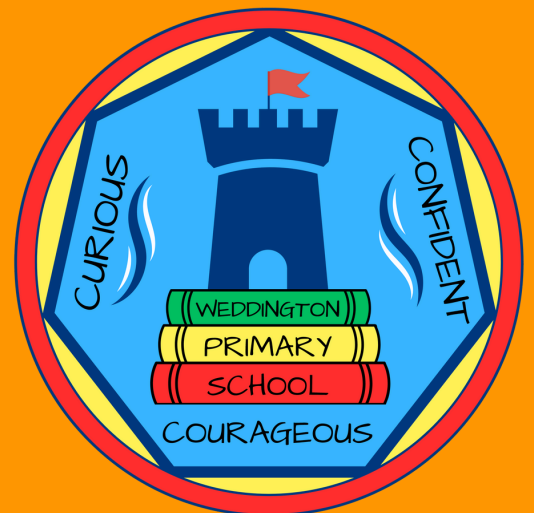
🟡 Stand behind the yellow line on the platform until the train has stopped.
