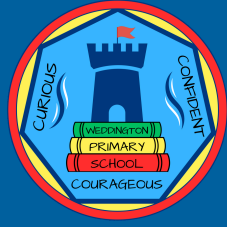

A big thank you to our fantastic families for your support in helping our children shine so brightly. Together, we build something special. 🌟



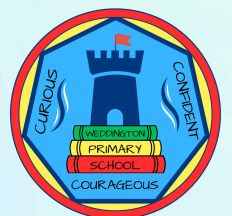
Weddy Graduate Day Aspiration

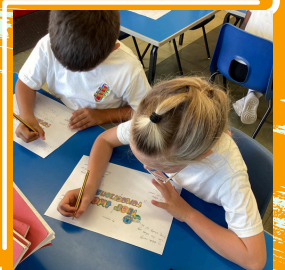
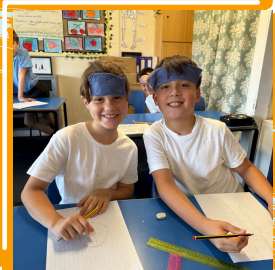

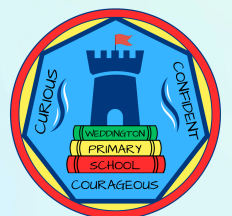
Weddy Graduate Day Reflection

Uniform

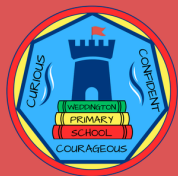
