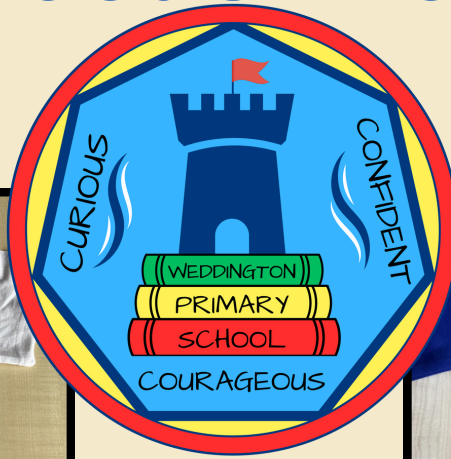

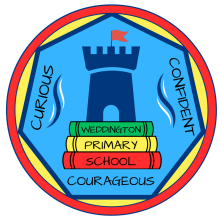
When asked why, Ashton simply said, “To keep the place nice, for our community... the environment.”

What a wonderful example of our children living Weddington’s values, even outside of school. We are so proud of them!

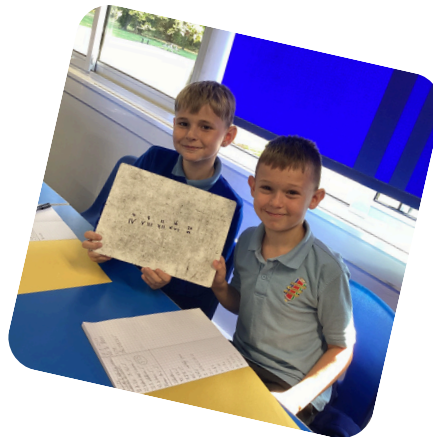
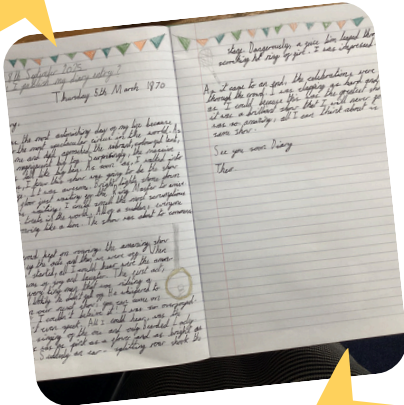
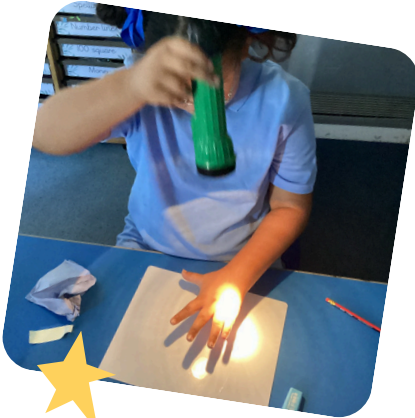
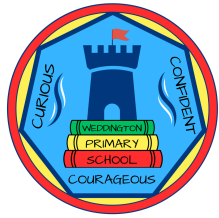

Gold Award

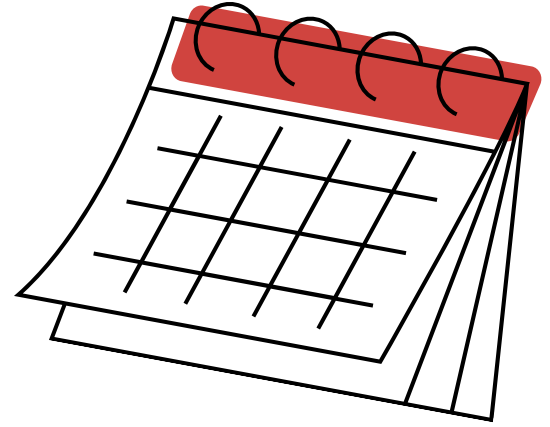

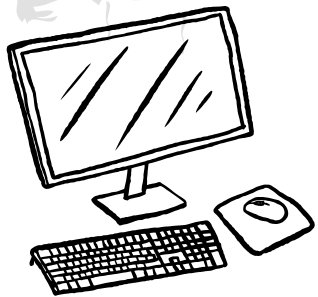

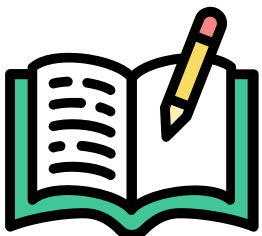
A Reminder About Smart Watches

If you do notice any further issues, please don't hesitate to email the school office, who will pass your message on, or pop in to speak with your child's teacher if you are able to.

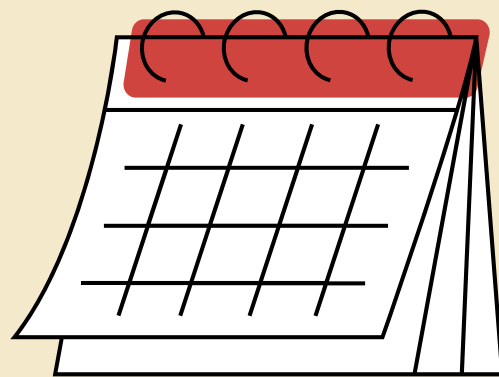

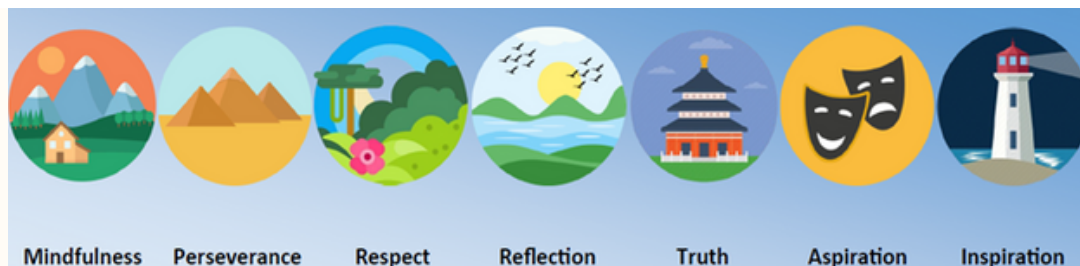
07 MINDFULNESS
