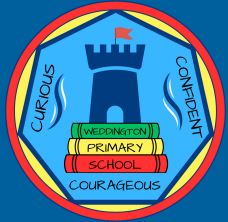

KS1 Values Assembly

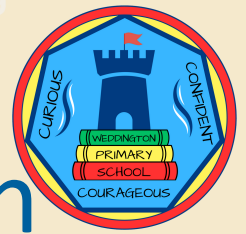

Educational Visits and Enrichment at Weddington



- Last year, we introduced two trips per year group (historically at Weddington, there has only been one trip per year for each year group).
- Of these, one trip was subsidised to £10, while the second was charged at full cost.
- This year, we are increasing our support: **the subsidised trip will now cost £7.50.**
- Children in receipt of **Pupil Premium** will continue to have the full cost of both trips covered by school. While future contributions may be considered, this year, we will continue to offer this support.
- Every year group will also enjoy a 'Weddy Enrichment' experience each term — with no cost to families. An example would be the 'Big Top' that had at the start of the term.
- Over the past two years, the school has worked incredibly hard to increase experiences and opportunities, ensuring every child has the chance to learn, grow and thrive.



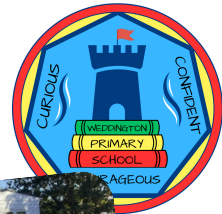
Reminder: We Are a Nut-Free School

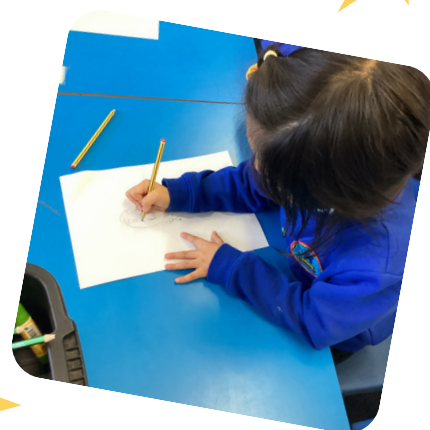
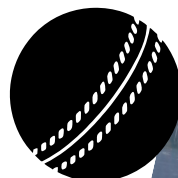




Our Learning This Week

Times Table Rock Star

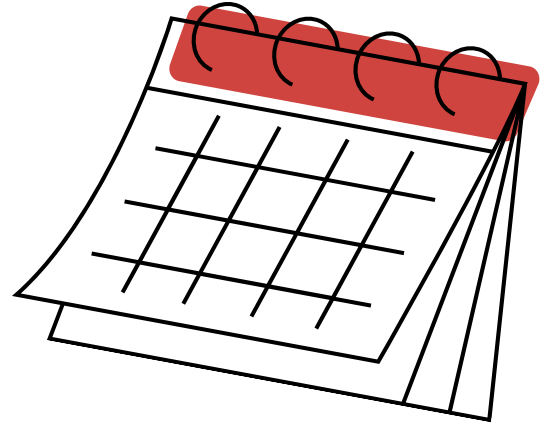
5 or 10 minutes each day will help children improve their skills and become more fluent and rapid in their recall of multiplication facts



5 to 10 minutes a day will help your child to become confident with the spellings. Don't forget you can practise them on paper or with magnetic letters as well.

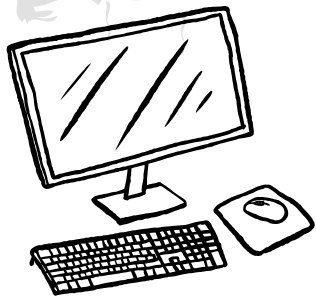
Year 6 parents

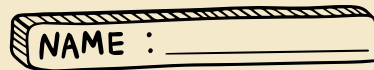
Local Walks

At Weddington, our Local Walk Trips Policy includes consent for local walks and visits within the community, which families provided when their child first joined us in Reception or joined us at Weddington in another year. This means we do not require new consent each year. As good practice, your child's class teacher will let you know in advance when these local trips will take place, giving you the opportunity to ask any questions. Please make sure all items of clothing are clearly labelled so that if they get lost they can be quickly returned to their owner. Last year, we had over 25 school jumpers unclaimed, none of them had a name.



Safeguarding and Child Protection at Weddington

At Weddington, keeping our children safe and happy is always our top priority. We regularly review our policies and procedures so that every child feels secure while in our care. While no system can ever be perfect, we do everything we can to make Weddington a safe place to learn and grow.

As part of our statutory duty, we also support children who may be vulnerable outside of school. This means that if a child shares something with us, or if we have any concerns about their wellbeing, we are required to report this to Social Care (Social Services). They are the professionals who will then investigate further to make sure the right support is in place.

Sometimes, this can lead to conversations with families that feel difficult. Please be assured that our role is always to put the safety and wellbeing of children first. We believe it is always better to raise a concern and find that it is not needed, than to miss something that could leave a child at risk.

Thank you for your continued support in helping us keep Weddington a safe and caring community for all our children.

Parking Safely

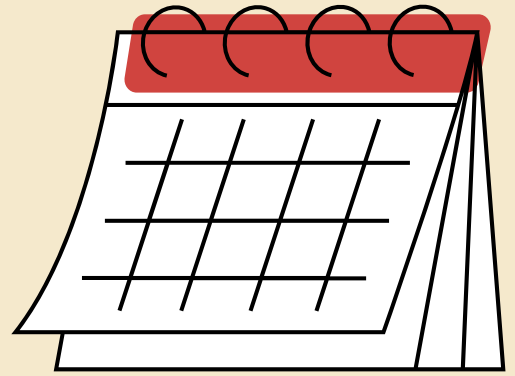
Navigating through parked cars is dangerous.

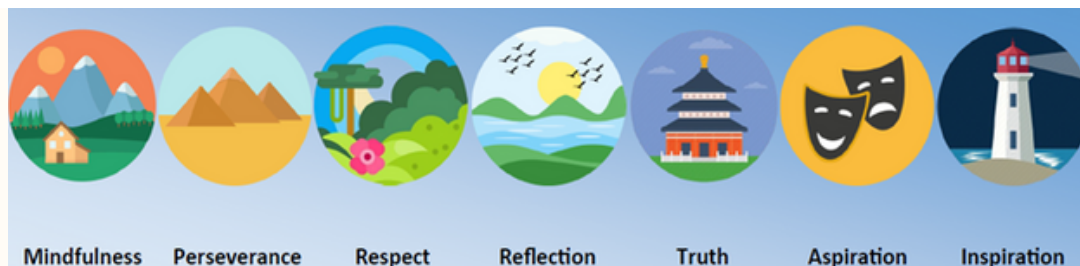
07 MINDFULNESS
