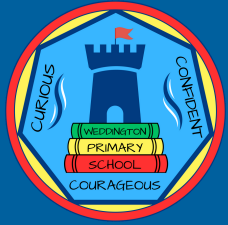

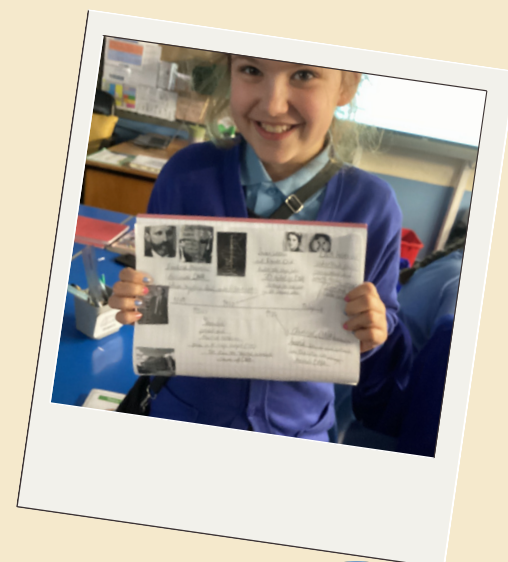
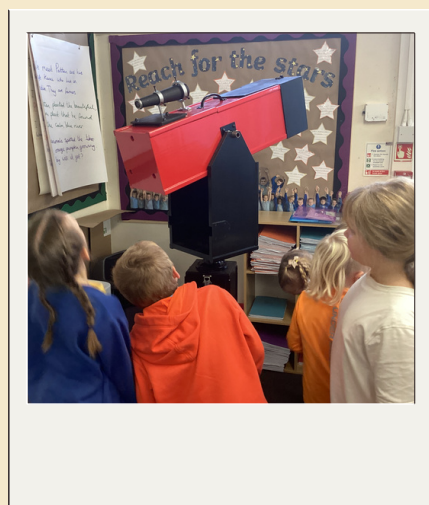

SCHOOL DROP OFF

For morning drop-offs, a reminder that the main gate to school will open at 8:25 am and the side doors to the school will open at 8:30 am.

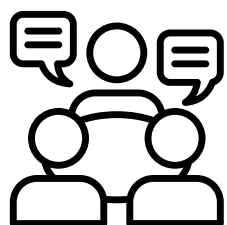
The gates will be closed at approximately 8:43 am. The reason these gates are closed at this time is that by the time children reach their classroom, they will be late and the side doors will be closed. This means all children will have to go through the main office.

We would encourage all parents to send their children into school for 8:30 am so there will not be any problem with the children being late for the start of their learning which is 8:45 am.

Children walking on their own must not arrive much earlier than 8.25am. Before the school doors open, children should not be playing on the equipment and parents should be monitoring children's behaviour at this time.

Lateness has improved in the past two years, but we still have many children who are consistently missing their learning at the start of the day. This of course is not fair on the child, but also to the rest of the class. One child being late does slow down the learning for the other children and teachers. Our Weddy Hub do a lot of work on attendance, so please get in touch with them should any families need any support with this.

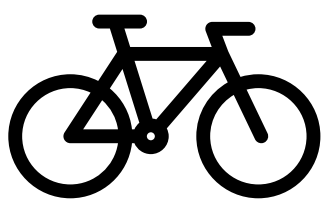

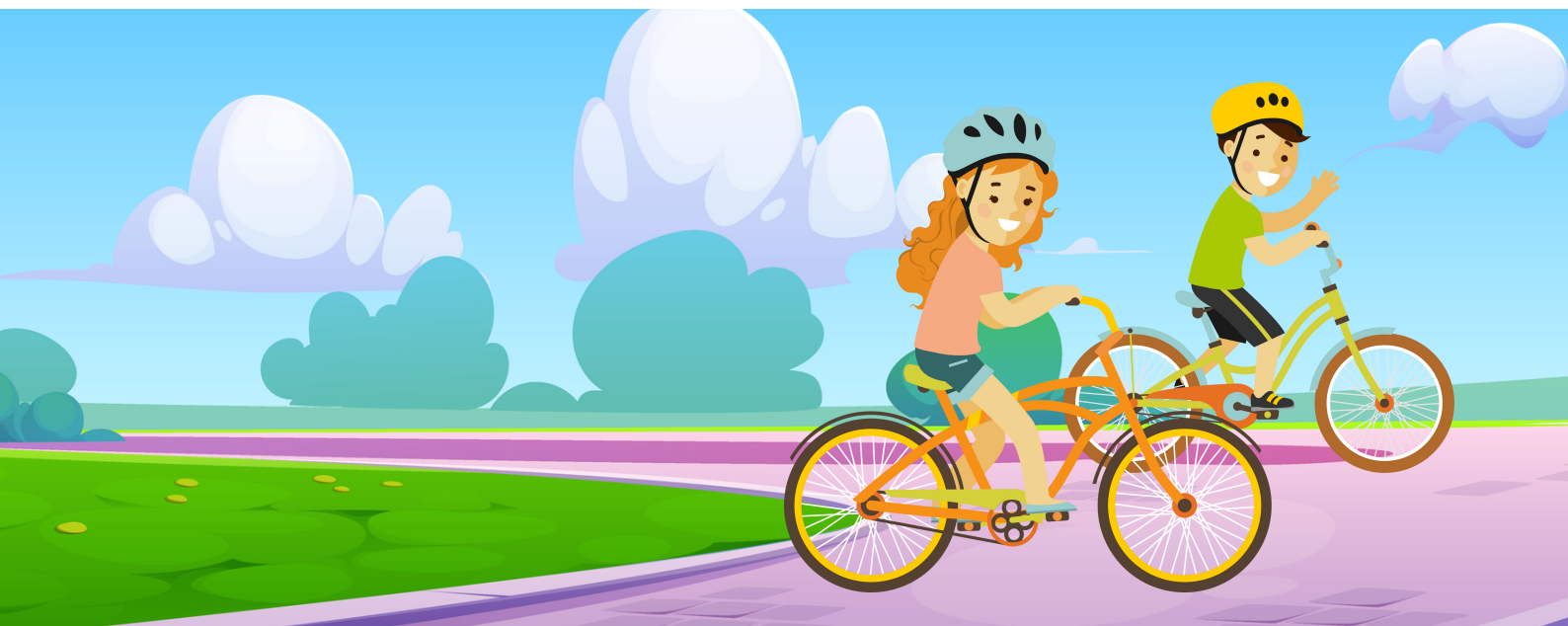

School Half Term - keeping safe

Out and About

Encourage children to stay in well-lit, familiar areas and avoid wandering alone.

Remind them to let someone know where they're going and when they'll be back.

If they're using bikes or scooters, helmets and road safety are a must.

Online Safety

With more free time, children may spend longer online. Make sure parental controls are in place and talk to them about staying safe on social media and gaming platforms.

Remind them never to share personal information or meet up with people they've only spoken to online.



Anti-Social Behaviour

Home Alone

FIREWORKS SAFETY TIPS

HERE ARE FIVE TOP TIPS TO KEEPING
CHILDREN SAFE ON BONFIRE NIGHT

1

Do not let children play with fireworks. Rockets and sparklers are very dangerous. If your teens want to use sparklers, make sure they keep them outside and away from their face, clothing, and hair

2

If you can, go to an organised fireworks display. If you do your own display make sure you have read all the safety instructions and never let children handle or light fireworks

3

Store fireworks in a safe, sturdy and childproof box and keep it away from children at all times. Fireworks always need handling with extreme care

4

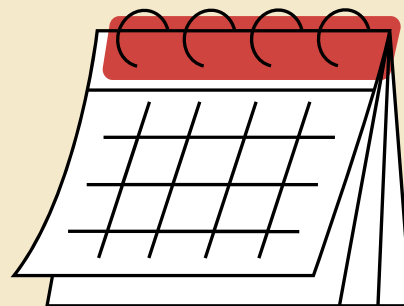
Always ensure children are supervised at all times. Never let a child pick up a used sparkler or unlit firework.

Make sure children aren't wearing loose clothing. Always have water or a fire extinguisher handy
