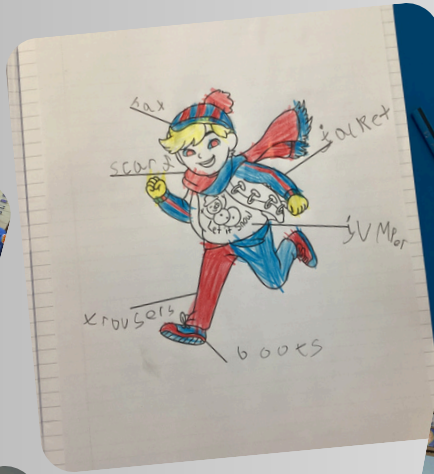
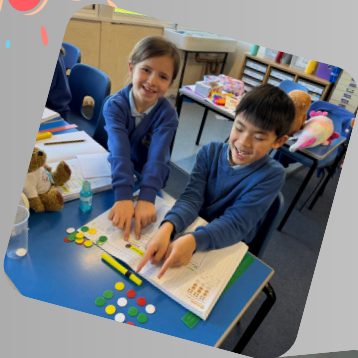

Maryam competed in a Birmingham open taekwondo championship this past weekend and earned a gold medal in sparring and a silver medal in patterns, in her age and weight category.



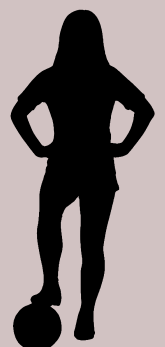
Jemima and Aria sang outside the Town Hall on Friday as part of the Christmas Lights switch on.

# Winter Weather Reminder – Keeping Our Children Warm and Safe



As the chilly winter weather settles in, we want to make sure all of our children stay warm, comfortable and ready to enjoy their day at school. We've noticed a number of children arriving without coats or choosing not to wear them outside, and with the temperature dropping, it's really important that they are wrapped up well.

Please can we ask that every child comes to school in a warm coat, and if possible, hats and gloves too. Cold hands and shivery little shoulders can make playtimes much less enjoyable!

To keep everyone safe, if a child does not have a coat on very cold days, they will unfortunately need to stay inside at break or lunchtime. We will always do our best to find a spare coat if available, but this may not always be possible, and we don't want anyone becoming unwell from the cold.

## A few helpful tips:

Please label all coats, hats, gloves and scarves so lost items can be quickly returned.

Shoes that are sensible for icy or wet ground are really helpful at this time of year.

Practising doing up zips and fastenings at home makes children more independent outdoors.

Thank you so much for your support in helping us look after the children – we want them to enjoy being outside, but more importantly to stay warm, healthy and safe.

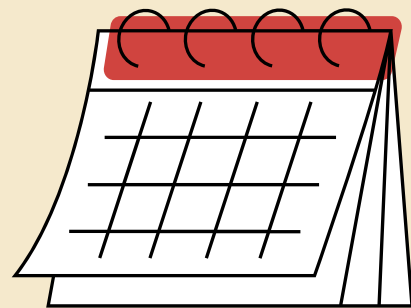
