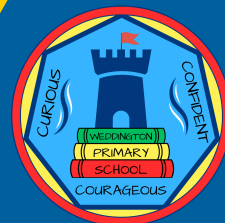

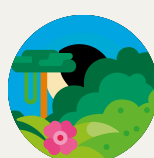

You have grown into curious, courageous and confident individuals

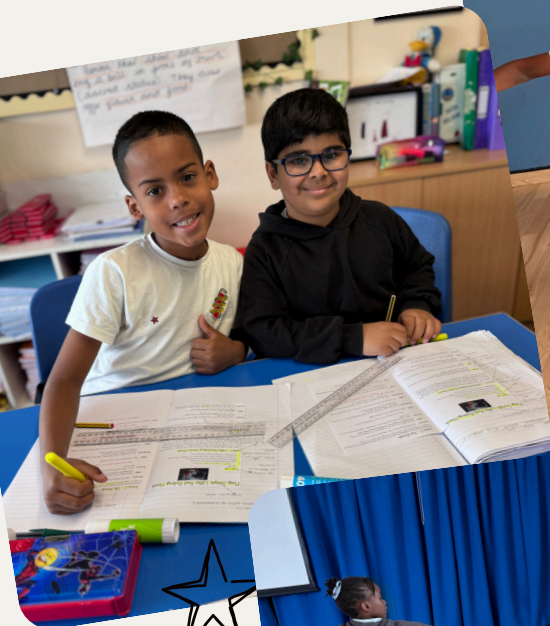
You are already making us incredibly proud
