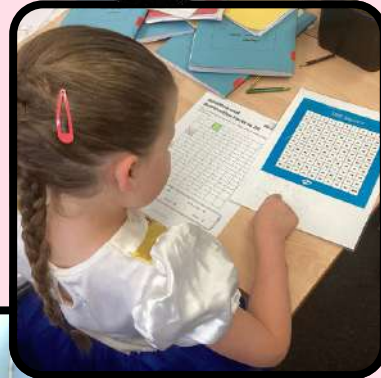
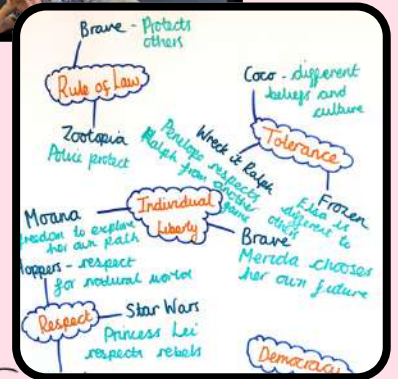

Disney Theme Week

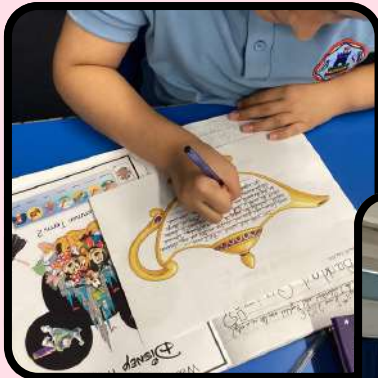
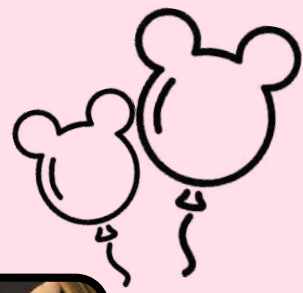

done, Rowling and Brunel – keep up the amazing work!

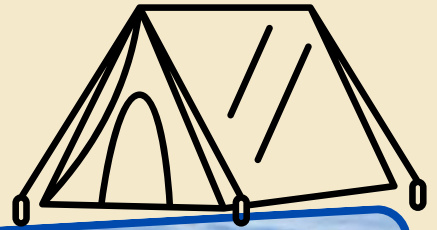


Den Day 2026

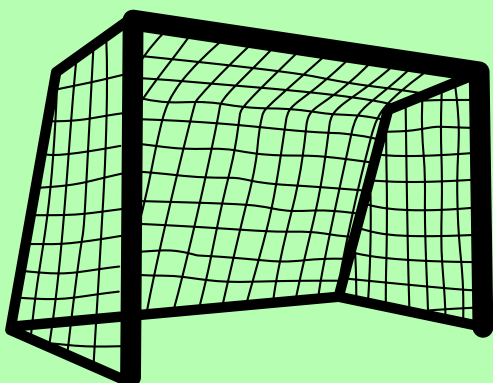

Showing great determination, skill, and resilience, the boys deservedly took the lead before the match finished in an exciting 1-1 draw against Milby.

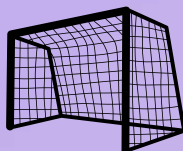

Weddy Graduates in the Wider Community



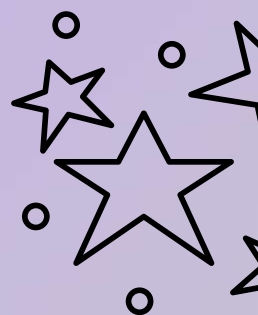
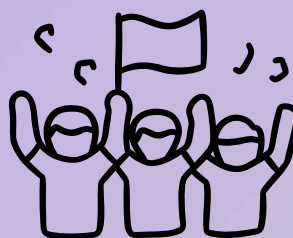
Isaac in Year 3 won the American Shootout at his football presentation by both scoring the most goals as shooter and letting the least amount through as goal keeper.

Parking Around School

Thank you to everyone who continues to park considerately and helps keep our children safe before and after school.

Unfortunately, we have received several reports of two serious concerns:

Children's safety

We have had a number of near misses where vehicles have driven onto the pavement or footpath, coming far too close to children and families. This is completely unacceptable and must stop.

Romsey Care Home

We have also been informed that vehicles linked to the school have repeatedly blocked the care home's private car park and driveway. On one occasion, this prevented an emergency vehicle from accessing the site. This is a huge worry.

If you drive to school, please park a little further away and walk the final part of your journey. Those few extra minutes help keep everyone safe.

We believe these concerns relate to a small number of families. We are continuing to gather information and will be contacting those involved where appropriate.

Finally, thank you to the local residents who have worked with us to find solutions.

We have now met with residents and have agreed a plan to improve parking and road safety around the school. We look forward to sharing more details over the coming weeks, ready for the start of the new academic year.

Thank you, as always, for your continued support in keeping our children, families and local community safe.
