English



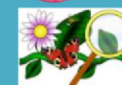
- Drawing Club stories will include Morris the Mankiest Monster, The Gruffalo and How I met My Monster
- We will be working on capital letters, full stops and finger spaces.
- We will be using nouns, adjectives and verbs to build a sentence.
- We will continue our RWI programme.

Maths



- We will continue learning about Place Value (within 10).
- We will practice addition and subtraction (within 10).
- We will learn all about 2D and 3D shapes and their properties.

Science



- This term in Science we will learn all about everyday materials and recycling.
- We will distinguish between an object and the material from which it is made.
- We will identify and name a variety of everyday materials, including wood, plastic, glass, metal, water, and rock.

Geography



- We will carry out field work studying our school grounds.
- We will be learning basic geographical vocabulary to refer to the human and physical features of our school.

History



- We will describe characteristics of certain toys and explore how toys have changed over time.
- We will explore simple toys from the past.

Art

- We will experiment with a variety of tools, such as: pencils, crayons, pastels, felt tips, charcoal, chalk and other dry media
- We will begin to explore the use of line, shape, pattern and colour.

Computing



- We will practice getting set up on our Chromebooks by using our personal login details.
- We will learn about staying safe online.

PSHE

- We will learn about Family and Relationships: family, friendships, emotions, working with others and friendship problems.
- We will learn about Health and Well-being: Personal self, understanding emotions, people who keep us healthy.

Design & Technology



- We will design purposeful, functional and appealing products.
- We will learn how to select from and use a range of tools and techniques to perform practical tasks.

PE



- We will have both indoor and outdoor PE lessons this term and take part in gymnastics, handball and dance.

RE

- We will discuss how might your religion or worldview be seen in the choices you make.
- We will discuss worldwide views including Christian, Dharmic, Muslim, Sikh, Islamic, Hindu.
