Here is what we will be learning...

English



- Texts- The Adventures of Odysseus by D Morden and H Lupton.
- Who let the Gods out? By Maz Evans
- Through inspiration from the texts the children will create a description, a letter a story a debate and more.
- Direct speech, modal verb, dashes.

Maths



- Place Value to 1 million.
- Addition and subtraction to more than 4-digit numbers.
- Multiplication and division.
- Fractions

Science



- Properties and changing materials
- Compare and group together everyday materials on the basis of their properties.
 - Set up investigations and give reasons based on evidence from comparative and fair tests.
 - Explore reversible and irreversible changes to a range of materials.

Geography



As part of our study of Ancient Greece, we will read and compare physical and political maps of Greece.

History



Ancient Greeks- Who, when, what and where were all the ancient Greeks. We will explore all the influences of the Ancient Greeks on modern life.

Art



We will develop our drawing skills by evaluating art from different artists and creating our own pointillism artwork.

Computing



This term we will recap the main messages around Internet safety and learn all about coding.

PSHE



Relationships- We explore all aspects of relationships with peers and ourselves as well as a variety of stereotypes. Health and wellbeing and taking care of ourselves.

Design & Technology



Sewing- In DT we will design and make our own nativity character.

PE

- Outdoor- Ball games. We will learn essential ball skills and using those skills as a team in a game.
- Indoor- Health and Wellbeing. Keeping active and confident when staying healthy.



RE

We will study the theme of 'Showing Belief' and look at how different religions celebrate some of their beliefs.



Music

Following our Charanga scheme we will learn how music brings us together- focussing on rock music
