Photo Permissions

Weddington Primary School takes all matters relating to child safety very seriously. This includes the use of images of pupils. Photographs and videos can motivate the pupils involved, provide a good opportunity to promote the school's work and are invaluable tools for professional training. However, schools have a duty of care towards pupils, meaning pupils must remain unidentifiable, reducing the risk of possible inappropriate contact.

Weddington Primary School follows these rules:

- Where media can be accessed externally, for example, the school website, school newsletters and the school's social media pages:
 - if the pupil is named, we avoid using their photograph; and
 - if their photograph is used, we avoid naming the pupil.
- When showcasing examples of pupils' work with accompanying photographs around the school, we will use only a child's first name.
- We would only ever use images of pupils suitably dressed.

We would like your consent to take photographs, films and other digital images of your children and to use them in the sorts of ways described above. If you are not happy for us to do this, we will accommodate your preferences.
